Modalities of utilization of funds

c) Monitoring and reporting mechanism for the projects or programmes;

The Board shall satisfy that the funds disbursed for CSR have been utilized for the purpose and in the manner as approved by it and Chief Financial Officer (CFO) will certify the same. The CSR Committee shall monitor the implementation of the CSR projects/programs/activities, including any ongoing project, if any, with the approved timelines and year wise allocation as per the CSR Policy and ensure compliance of the provisions related to CSR mentioned in the Companies Act, 2013 and the Rules made thereunder from time to time. Further the CSR committee is competent to make modifications, if any for smooth implementation of the project within the overall permissible time period. The progress of CSR initiatives and activities will be reported by the CSR Committee to the Board on a regular basis.
